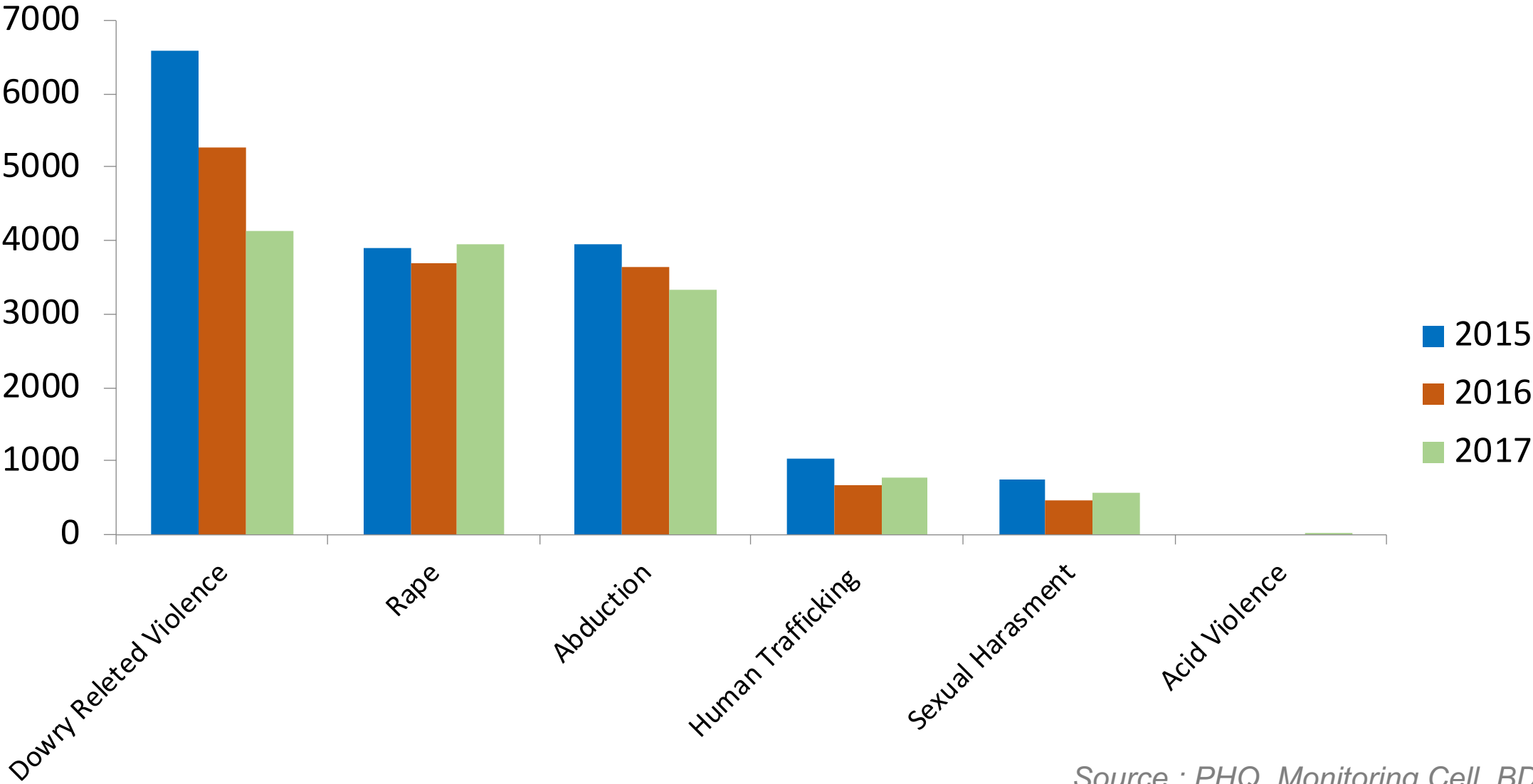

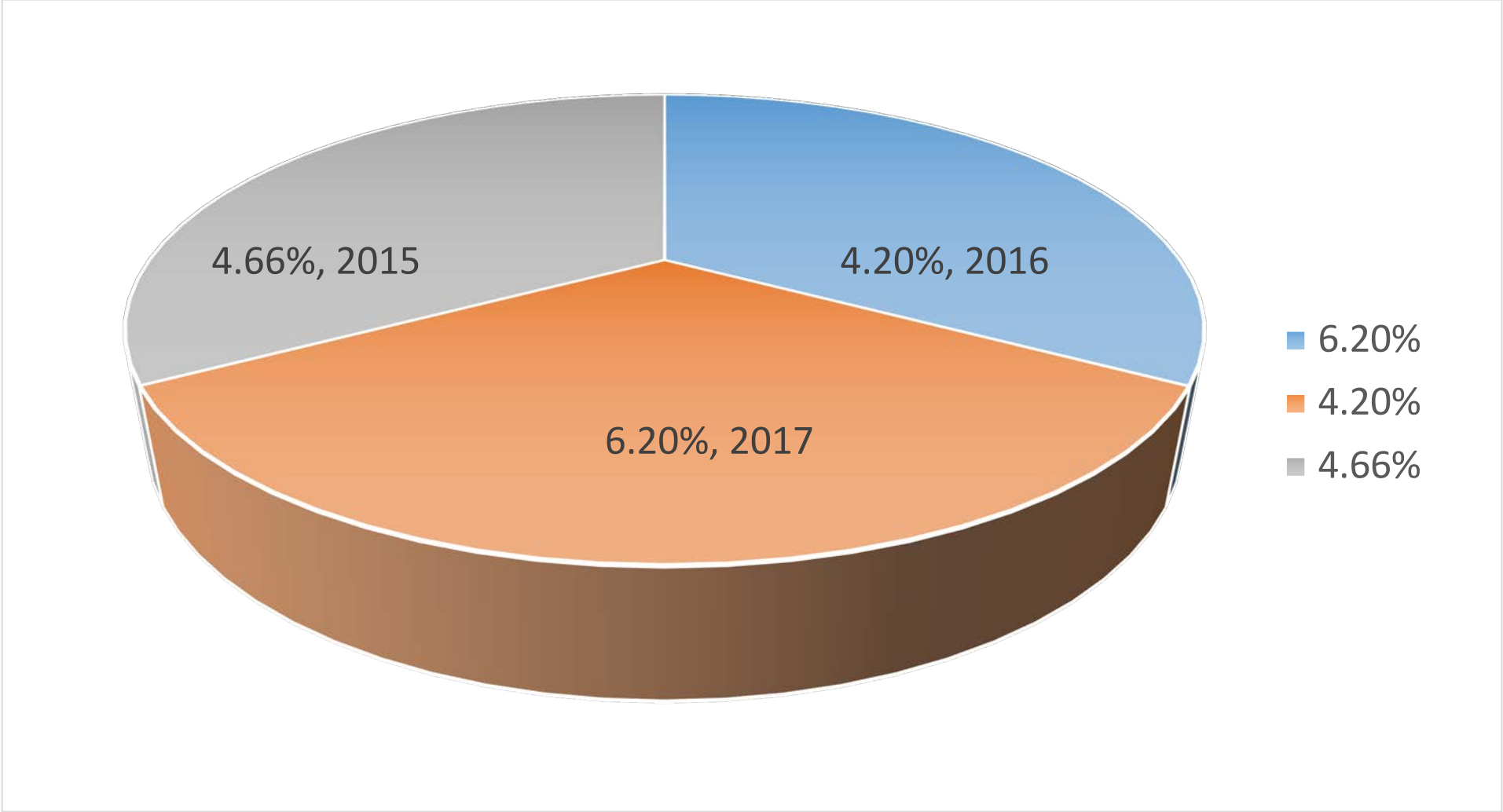
# Type and Trends FIR (2015-2017)

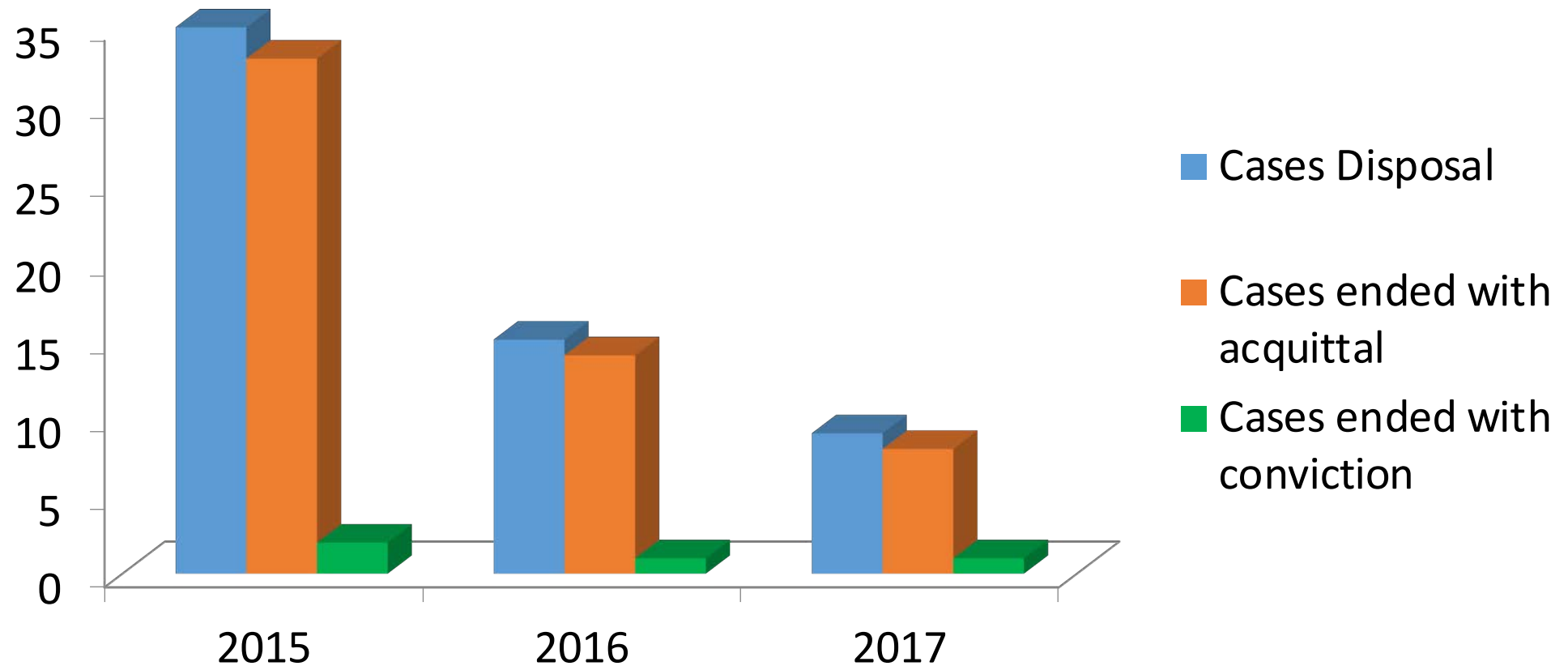

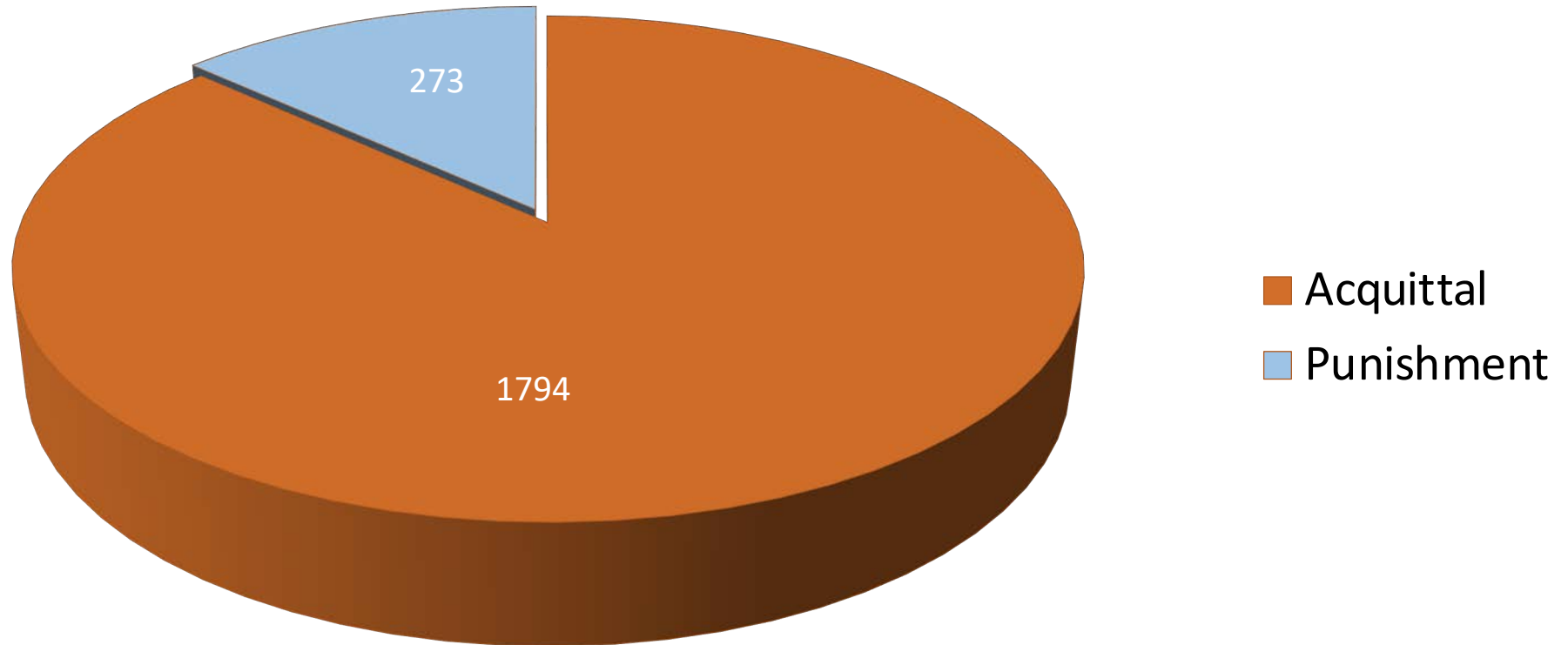
## Human Trafficking Conviction Rate Near to 6.7%

# Reasons for low Conviction Rate.

Sample size (Investigating Officers)	200
Victim Compromising Attitude	30%
Poor Collection of Physical Evidence	16%
Delayed Reporting to the Police Station	15%
Lack of Eye Witness	12%
Lengthy Process	10%
Non-Cooperation of Public Prosecutor	8%
Mistake of Fact	5%
Insufficient Number of Women Police	2%
Other Reasons	2%

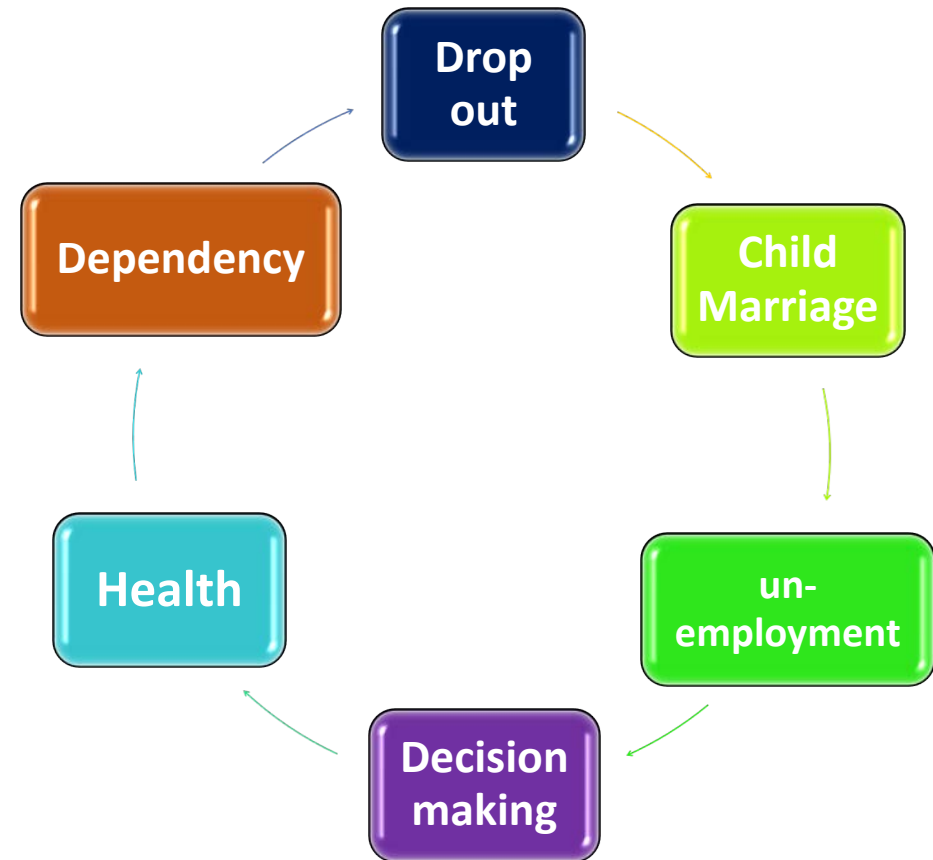
# Ways for ensuring judgment

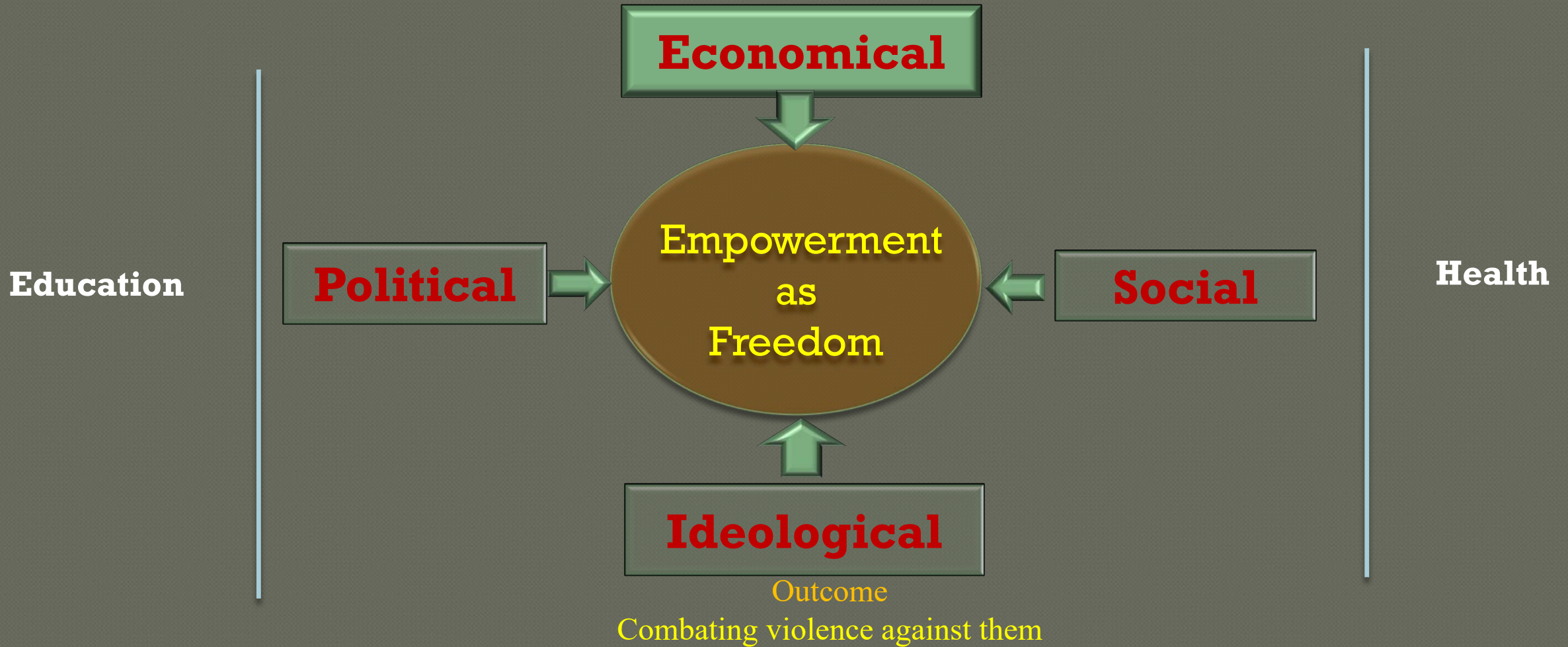
