Motivation and goals

Goals

- Protecting victims of extreme intimidation in their home environments
- Stop the situation of extreme intimidation and harassment

Basic principle

- if the situation can't be stopped, - as a last resort - it has to be the perpetrator who moves out of his house and not the victims.



Manifestation of the problem

- Anti-social behavior is accompanied by crimes
- Crimes involved: damage / destruction of properties, assault, threat
- The intimidation takes place in the direct home environment
- The perpetrator lives in the direct home environment
- Uncontested victimization
- Repeated victimization
- One or more victims, one or more perpetrators



Which are our actions?

- Collecting information (police, housing institutions, municipality)
- Building a file
- Addressing the perpetrator
- Combining actions:
 - criminal, civil and administrative law
 - (mental) healthcare
- Keeping in touch with the victim(s)

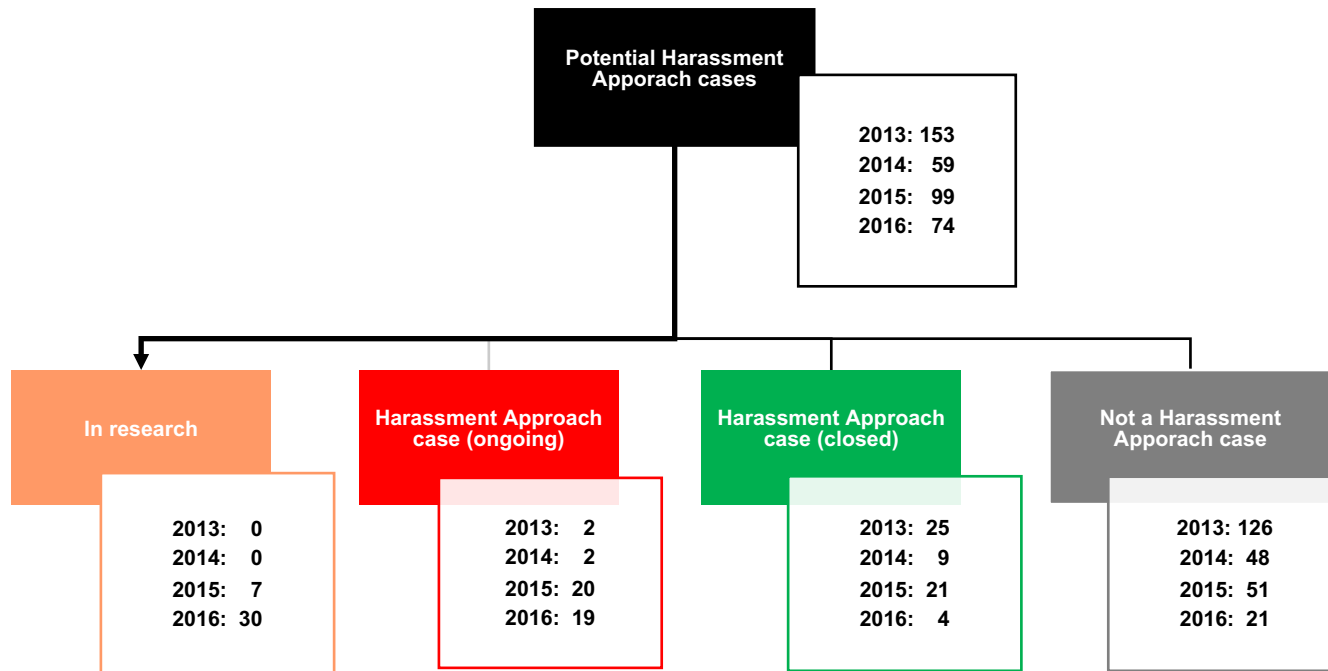


What was organised

- Administrative priority
- Full collaboration of the public prosecution service, police organisation, housing institutions, (child) health care organisations, municipality
- Projectcontrol by the municipality
- City districts case managers (7)
